The province issued a media release and a press conference was held in Brandon on June 11th

*"Government is providing up to \$146,500 to support the design and development of the new Pocket Park in partnership with the YMCA of Brandon and Renaissance Brandon, Municipal Government Minister Stan Struthers announced in Brandon today."*

Renaissance Brandon Chair Shaun Cameron has stepped down from the Board of Directors but will continue to be a strong proponent for the organization and wishes them continued success.

Vice Chair Steve McMillan has taken over the position of Chairperson for the Board of Directors for Renaissance Brandon. Michael Cox has been nominated and accepted the position of Vice Chair.

Renaissance Brandon will have a BU student conducting interviews with downtown stakeholders this summer to provide insight into ideas and concerns as well as the HUB revitalization progress, strategic planning and future communication.

The staff and board members have continued to meet with Brandon city council members to discuss the core operational structure of Renaissance Brandon going forward.

A draft of the 3 year Strategic Plan for Renaissance Brandon has been submitted and is under review by the board.

The 9th Street Land Assemblage consultant presented their initial findings from the Land Marketability Study along with some preliminary design sketches.

2 Redevelopment project applications were reviewed, discussed and approved. Renaissance Brandon will be announcing these two projects once occupancy permits have been obtained.
